This section is not to exceed 8 single spaced pages and must detail the nominee's measurable and exemplary leadership contribution to their peers, service and community.

Supporting Materials

Any newspaper clippings, videos, magazine and trade articles or any other material in support of the nominee's application may also be submitted. Items that are not transmittable via electronic means must be received by the February 13, 2012 deadline to be considered.

Any application not fulfilling these requirements will be disqualified.
